

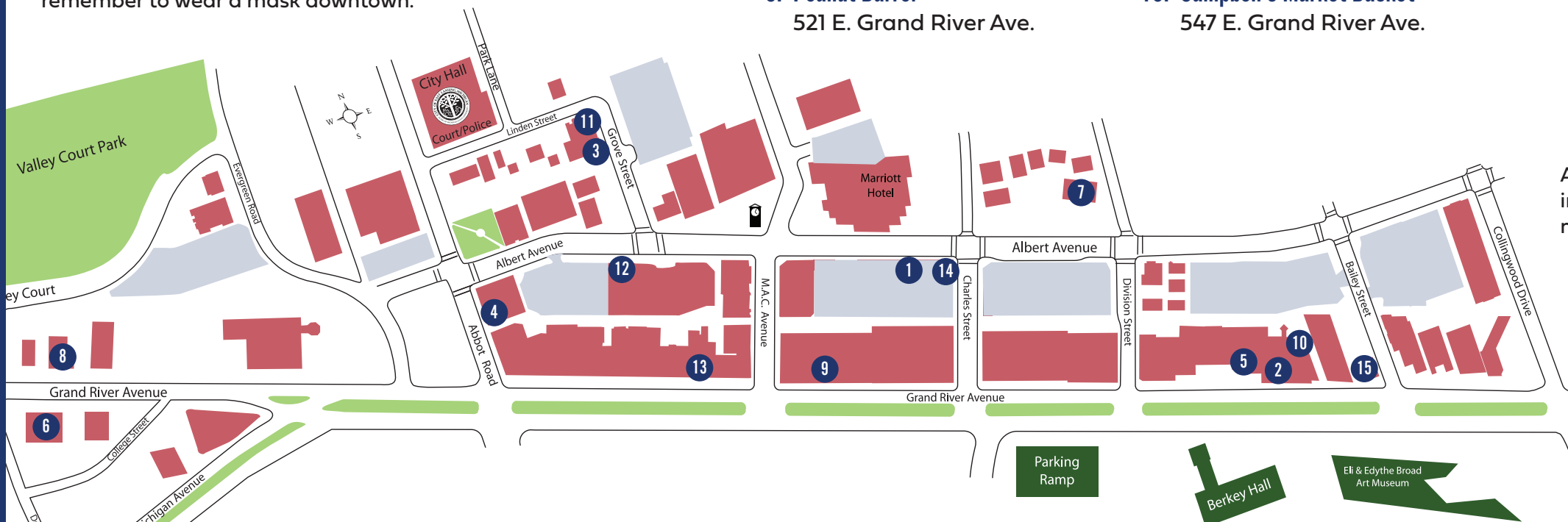
ELHS FAMILY STRONG Art Exhibit Map

As a part of the "Daytime. Nighttime. Anytime. Place Project," the East Lansing Downtown Development Authority (DDA) will be hosting three community art exhibits in downtown East Lansing this winter and spring.
