This is to provide notification that water main, sewer and roadway construction project is scheduled to begin on Evergreen Avenue the week of February 22, 2021. Please refer to the maps included for the extent of the project. These improvements are part of an ongoing program to improve the infrastructure throughout the City. The contractor for this project is Sandborn Construction, Inc. out of Portland, Michigan.

Persons with disabilities may participate in the meeting through the methods set forth above. Individuals with disabilities requiring auxiliary aids or services in order to attend electronically should notify Nicole McPherson at nmcphe@cityofeastlansing.com, within a reasonable time in advance of the meeting

Representatives from the City's engineering staff, consulting engineers, and the Contractor will be on hand to provide an overview of the project and what to expect during the construction. Following the short presentation, ample time will be available to answer questions.

The roadway will be closed to through traffic during construction to assist in expediting the work schedule. Local traffic will be maintained for residential access. Please understand that you may be redirected from one end of the street or the other at various times, to complete the scheduled improvements within the roadway. Residents are asked to use alternate routes of travel when possible during the project.

Refuse/recycling collection and mail delivery **will not** be disrupted during construction and, unless notified otherwise, all refuse/recycling should be placed at or near the curb in the normal manner. Please have all refuse and recycling containers out by 7:30 a.m. on your

collection day as City crews will be in this area early to avoid conflicts with road construction crews.

Street lighting in your area may also be impacted during construction. Due to the close proximity of the underground electric cables to the construction activities, the streetlights in your area may be turned off in order to protect the construction personnel performing the work. The streetlights will be turned back on as soon as the construction progresses to a stage where the utility company can safely re-install the wires and restore power to them.

Property owners are responsible for invisible underground fencing and sprinkler systems placed within the street right-of-way. The City asks that property owners clearly mark these systems with flags or stakes to show their location. The contractor shall make every effort to avoid these private systems during construction; however, if they are damaged by construction activities, the property owner must bear the expense of repairing or replacing them.

We realize the construction work will be inconvenient and disrupt routines. Your understanding and cooperation with the City's efforts to improve the infrastructure in your neighborhood is greatly appreciated. The City will provide a project inspector, who will be in the area daily to address any problems that may arise.

If you have any questions or have any special needs or concerns, please contact us at the East Lansing Engineering Department. I would ask that you email me if you wish to be included in general updates during the project, to keep you better informed of progress and schedule.

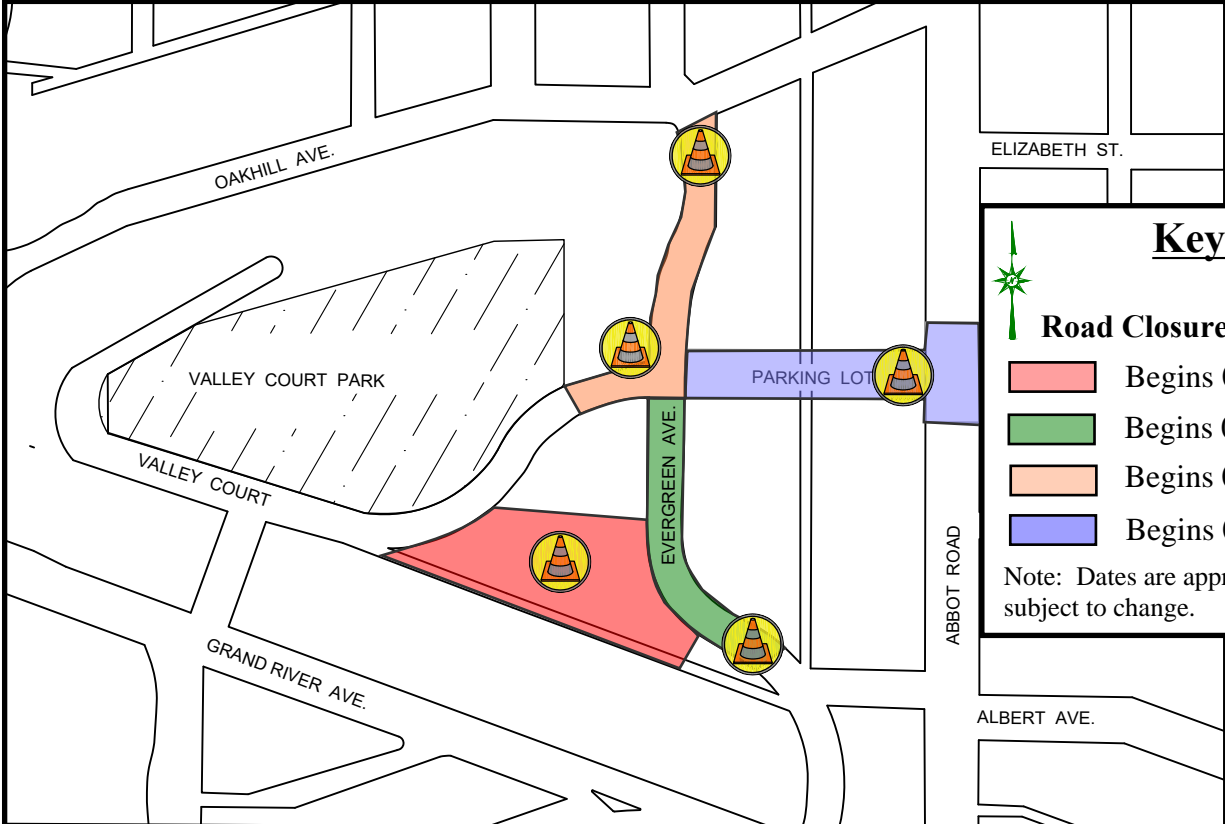

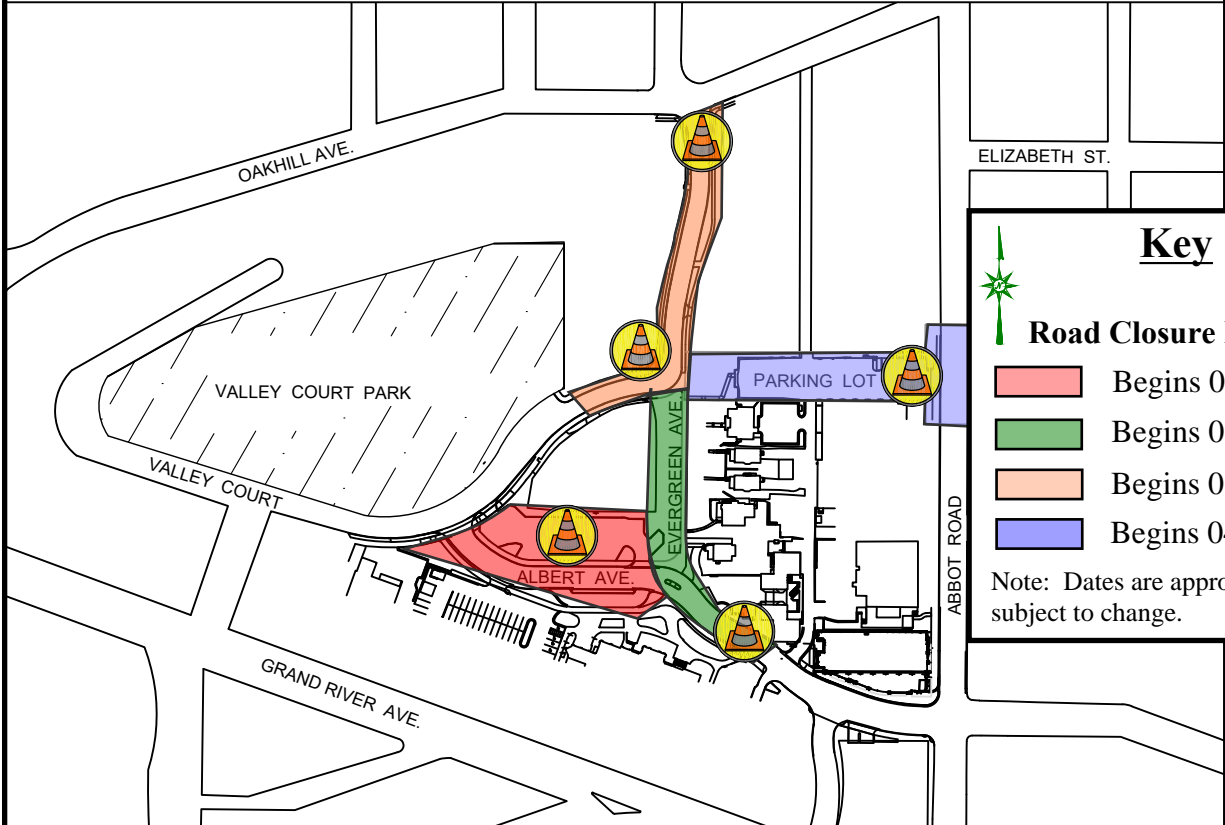
