## **LOCAL STREET IMPROVEMENTS TO BE COMPLETED IN YOUR NEIGHBORHOOD**

### **2021 LOCAL STREETS RESURFACING PROJECT**

**- Charles St, Division St, - Roseland Ave, Maplewood Dr, Oakland Dr, -  
-Blanchette Dr, Gainsborough Dr. –**

The 2021 Local Streets Resurfacing project will begin shortly. You are receiving this flyer because your residence may be affected by the construction. A map of the project area is included on the reverse side. Work consists of select curb and gutter replacement, sidewalk ramp upgrades, and roadway milling and resurfaced. Michigan Paving and Materials Company will be constructing this project.

The project is scheduled to begin July 12, 2021 (weather permitting) and extend through the fall, starting with Charles and Division Street and then proceeding to the local streets. Equipment, materials, and traffic control items will begin to arrive the week of July 5. Streets will be closed to through traffic, however local traffic will always be maintained.

Refuse collection and mail delivery will not be disrupted during construction and, unless notified otherwise, all rubbish should be placed at or near the curb in the normal manner. Please have all refuse and recycling containers out by 7:30 AM on your collection day as City crews will be in this area early to avoid conflicts with road reconstruction crews.

Street lighting in your area may also be impacted during construction. Due to the proximity of the underground electric cables to the construction activities, the streetlights in your area may be turned off to protect the construction personnel performing the work. The streetlights will be reenergized as soon as the construction progresses to a stage where the utility company can safely reinstall the wires and restore power to them.

Property Owners are responsible for invisible underground fencing and sprinkler systems placed within the street right-of-way. The City would ask that property owners clearly mark these systems with flags or stakes to show their location. The contractor shall make every effort to avoid these private systems during construction, however, if they are damaged by construction activities, the property owner must bear the expense of repairing or replacing them.

Below are details about the project informational meeting that has been scheduled to provide more detailed information about the project, including the project schedule and proposed sequence of construction events. This meeting is intended for the public to be able to join at their convenience and ask questions. The public meeting information is as follows:

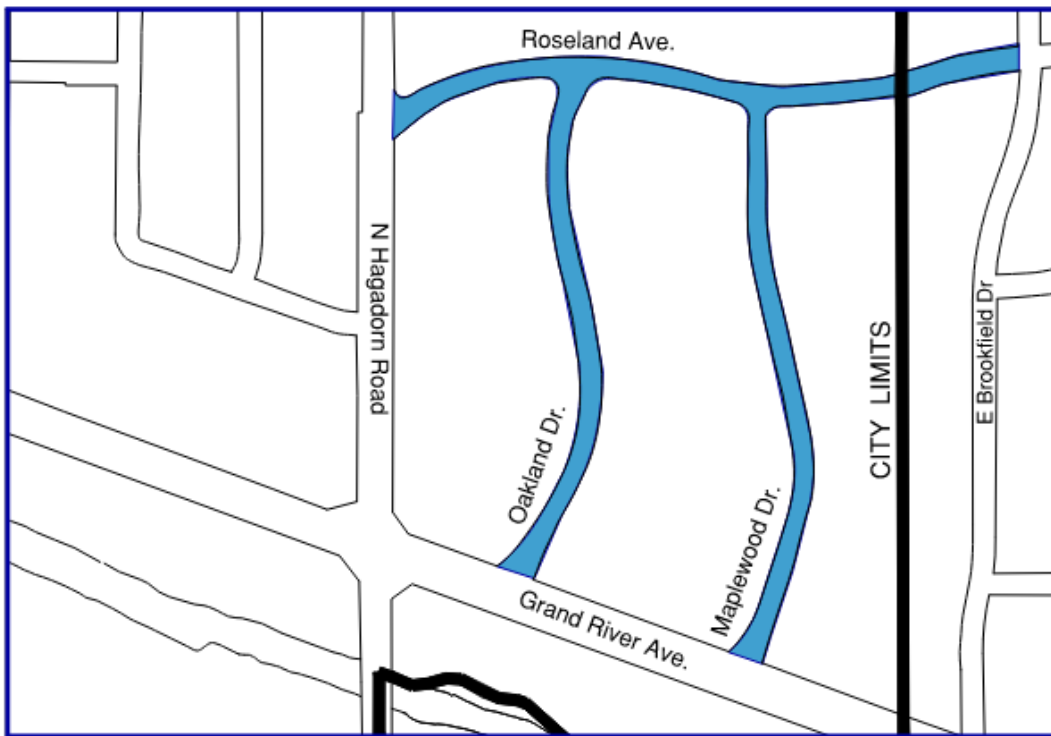
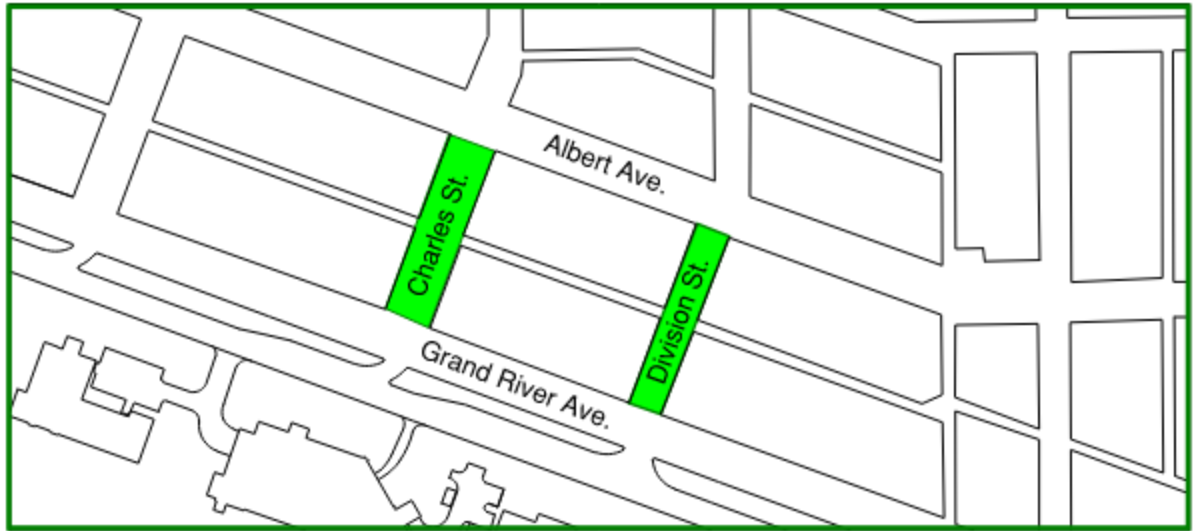
