

## East Glencairn Neighborhood Improvements Project Frequently Asked Questions

- 1.) **When will the project be completed?** This project is now scheduled to be completed in mid July 2022 due to unexpected project delays, including reduced material availability, longer-than-usual lead times due to COVID-19 and weather impacts. All work originally planned will still be completed.
- 2.) **What work will be completed in 2022?** Please refer to the map on the back for the area to be completed next year. The main area of construction will be the utility work (water and sewer main replacement) on Northlawn Avenue, from Harrison Road to Rosewood Avenue.
- 3.) **How will the project be left when work concludes in 2021?** Before work concludes in 2021, all curb and gutter, sidewalks and drives that have been removed will be replaced. All roads will also be paved to provide a hard surface over the winter.
- 4.) **What is the tentative schedule for the construction work next year?** The below time frame is weather dependent:
  - a. Late March 2022 – Begin water main replacement along Northlawn Avenue at Harrison Road and progress east towards Rosewood Avenue.
  - b. Beginning of May 2022 – Water service replacements on Northlawn Avenue
  - c. Middle of May 2022 – Begin sewer replacement along Northlawn Avenue, between Harrison Road and Rosewood Avenue.
  - d. June 2022 – Begin road building process along Northlawn Avenue, between Harrison Road and Rosewood Avenue. Mill and overlay Glenhaven Avenue, Roxburgh Avenue and Rosewood Avenue.
  - e. July – Pave streets, restoration and cleanup
