

ELPD Use of Force Summary for October 2021

10/2/21 – Officers were *dispatched* to assist bar staff with a subject that would not leave. Upon officer arrival they asked her to leave multiple times. She eventually stood up and wanted to continue drinking her drink. She was taken into custody for trespass.

Officer – B/M & H/F

10/2/21 – Officers did have to place a subject's hands behind his back due to him not wanting to be handcuffed. He was arrested for OWI.

10/2/21 – Officers witnessed two subjects fighting outside of a bar. Both were initially secured and after investigation only one was arrested as the aggressor of the fight.

10/2/21 – An Officer did grab a male by the arm and lead him toward her patrol vehicle to cite him for Open Alcohol, after advising him to dump it out and he continued to drink the open alcohol.

10/3/21 – Officers witnessed a couple subject actively fighting in Ann St. Triangle. Both were arrested and had to forcibly restrained (pulled apart from fighting & arms forced behind their back) and handcuffed.

10/5/21 – Officers were *dispatched* to a Home Invasion in progress. Upon arrival the suspect was located inside, he was ordered out and taken into custody without incident. Officers did have their weapons drawn during this event.

10/7/21 – Officers were *dispatched* to a subject threatening people with a knife downtown. Upon arrival an Officer drew his weapon while confronting the armed suspect who still had the knife in hand. The suspect put down the knife and was taken into custody. He did make homicidal comments to the officer after his arrest.

10/7/21 – Officers were *dispatched* to a bar for an unwanted subject who allegedly was touching people inappropriately. Upon arrival the suspect tried to reenter the establishment. The third time the subject tried he was taken into custody....he did resist the officers.

10/7/21 – A officer made a traffic stop for a safety violation. The suspect refused to exit his car for field sobriety testing. After 25 minutes he finally did exit the car and was arrested.

On 10/19/21 Officers were *dispatched* to check on a female subject with a mental detainer order. Upon contacting her they did have to handcuff her. She showed light resistance to this, and the officers did place her arms behind her back and secure her. She was transported for the medical attention.

On 10/24/21 an Officer witnessed two females on the ground physically fighting downtown. He did pull them apart and secure them both. Once in the jail a female officer had to escort one of the suspects away from other to avoid an altercation.

On 10/25/21 Officers were *dispatched* to an unwanted subject; upon arrival it was determined that the call was a domestic assault. The female subject had punched the male subject in the eye. Upon officers trying to arrest her she showed resistance and her arms were forcibly placed behind her back and cuffed. She did try breaking away from the arresting officer and tried striking them after being cuffed.

On 10/25/21 Officers were dispatched to check for a juvenile who was trying to run-away and in need of mental evaluation. They were able to eventually find and secure her. She was turned back over to her parent for treatment.

10/27/21 – Officers were *dispatched* to wounded deer on the northside of the city. One officer did use his duty issued weapon to put the deer down.

10/29/21 – Officers were *dispatched* to a possible theft, and it was reported the suspect was armed with a dangerous weapon (edged weapon). Upon arrival store staff had the subject restrained on the ground. One officer did handcuff the subject for safety during the investigation.

10/30/21 – Officer was *dispatched* to a car vs. deer accident. The officer did have to use his sidearm to put the deer down.

10/30/21 – Officers witnessed two subjects physically fighting downtown. The officers did arrest both subjects.

10/30/21 – Officers were *dispatched* for a subject who had jumped on a moving fire truck. Upon officers arrival they did handcuff the suspect during their interaction with him for safety reasons.

10/30/21 – Officers were responding to the area where the car was flipped over in Cedar Village. A subject was grabbed hold of who was seen physically trying to rock the vehicle. He was grabbed a hold of and was taken away from the vehicle and issued a citation for Disorderly.

Subject – H/M
Officers – 3 W/M & H/F

10/31/21 – Numerous Officers responded to the sounds of gunfire from a ramp downtown. Officers did have their weapons drawn/displayed as they contacted multiple people in the ramp who were nearby or involved with a shooting that had just occurred. There were multiple people secured for safety reasons. One victim was located, and officers rendered life-saving treatment.
