#### 11.1 PURPOSE

The purpose of this procedure is to establish guidelines for the utilization and mobilization of the Ingham Regional Special Response Team (IR SRT).

#### 11.2 UTILIZATION

The Ingham Regional Special Response Team (IR SRT) will respond to incidents in Ingham County for member and non-member agencies. In the event you are considering IR SRT to assist, review the circumstances listed below that IR SRT will mobilize / respond to and then follow the instructions as outlined.

IR SRT will respond to assist Ingham County law enforcement agencies with the following situations:

1. Barricaded or Homicidal Person(s)
  2. High Risk Arrest or Search Warrants
  3. Hostage Situations
  4. Civil Disturbance
  5. Dignitary Protection
  6. Other time sensitive, special threat situations
- Regarding suicidal subjects: If a suicidal subject is alone in their home and are threatening to kill themselves, this is **NOT** barricaded gunman unless they have fired on officers or the public. If the suicidal subject would pose a significant threat to the community if they become mobile, then the IR SRT may respond to provide containment of the subject. The IR SRT will not generally make entry on a suicidal subject unless a crime has been committed.

### 11.3 **CALL-OUT PROCEDURE / MOBILIZATION**

If you believe the IR SRT is needed to assist, call the On-Duty Ingham Regional 911 Center Supervisor immediately at **(517) 272-6000**.

Be prepared to provide the 911 Center Supervisor with at least one phone number where you can be reached so the On-Duty IR SRT Commander can return your call directly.

Whenever an IR SRT Operation is being contemplated in the City of East Lansing, the IR SRT Commander or his / her designee shall confer with Uniform Shift Supervisor. The purpose of this meeting will be to determine the feasibility of the proposed operation and to allow time to adjust / allocate the necessary personnel and assets needed to assist.

### 11.4 **RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE SHIFT SUPERVISOR**

The Uniform Shift Supervisor shall attend the IR SRT Pre-Operation Briefing. Also included will be the Uniform Division personnel assigned to the pending IR SRT operation.

Prior to the execution of the IR SRT operation, the Shift Supervisor shall notify all on-duty Uniform Patrol personnel as to the location of the pending IR SRT operation.

The Shift Supervisor will not actively engage in the operation, but will place himself / herself in a position so that he / she are aware of the actions of the IR SRT. The Shift Supervisor will take command to direct supporting units should there be any unusual activity or difficulty in the operation.

The Shift Supervisor shall assign sufficient personnel so the IR SRT personnel can be released from the scene of the operation as soon as the scene is secured.

### 11.5 **SCENE RESPONSIBILITIES**

In the event the IR SRT operation or actions at the scene require additional investigation, the Shift Supervisor or his / her designee shall have the authority and responsibility to manage the scene. If ELPD Investigations Division personnel are called to the scene, they shall assume command of the scene upon arrival.

### 11.6 **REPORTING**

An ELPD IR SRT member will complete a report of the IR SRT's involvement in the operation when directed to do so by the IR SRT Commander.
