Volunteer Job Descriptions

Art Studio Volunteer:

- Oversees the usage of the Art Studio in non-class times. Is knowledgeable about equipment, machines, etc., and helps users with their projects.

East Lansing Public Schools Volunteer:

- Do you have a couple of hours a week to work with students who need extra time and attention in our schools? Prime Time's school volunteer program is developing and we are hoping to eventually provide volunteers in many capacities to the schools.

Adopt-A-Grandparent:

- Adopt-A-Grandparent is a co-mentoring initiative that seeks to pair MSU Community Relations Coalition (CRC) Interns with active and engaged Prime Time Seniors to support significant one-on-one relationships. The program supports and empowers seniors and encourages sharing across the generations.

Art Buddies:

- Art Buddies is an intergenerational art program with students from East Lansing High School's Transitional Program. The program meets for six weeks on Monday mornings, usually from February to April.

On-Call Volunteer:

- Are you available to fill brief, short term needs that arise throughout the year; such as helping with events, luncheons or Fit for Life pre-and post-testing?

Prime Time Ambassador:

- Are you willing to share your enthusiasm for Prime Time with other groups around the city? You could be part of a team presenting Prime Time program information to church groups, senior health sites, and other local groups. Prime Time Ambassadors could also connect with individuals who are new members; helping to make them feel welcome.

Friends of Prime Time:

- This volunteer sits on the board and helps direct fund investing and distribution.

Senior Commission:

- The nine member commission is appointed by City Council and advises them on issues which affect local senior citizens. Monthly meetings take place on the first Monday of the month at 1:30 pm (no meetings in August and January).
