96% of MSU students disapprove of getting into fights or arguments due to drinking.

**M**ay you find the true meaning of the day, not in drink, but in friendship and camaraderie.

87% of MSU students said they stay with the same group of friends while they are drinking to help keep themselves safe.

**M**ay you know the joy of spirited celebration, rather than celebration full of only spirits.

9 out of 10 MSU students eat before or while drinking to help control the negative effects of alcohol.
