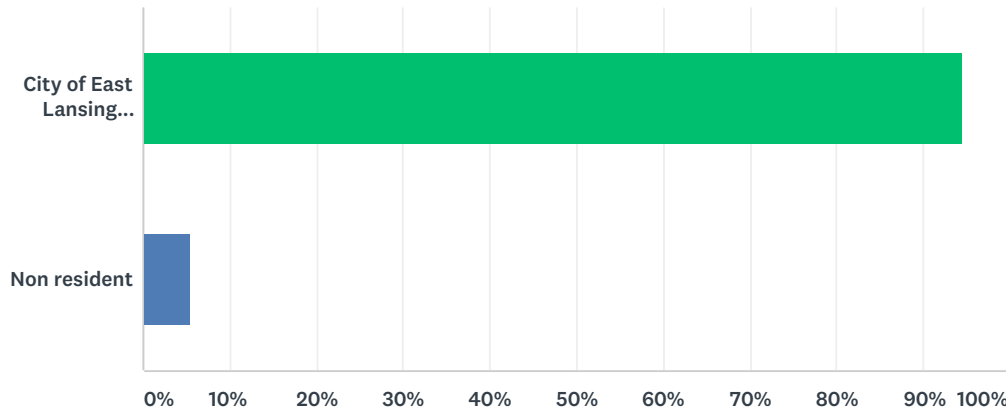


# Q1 Please choose the category that describes you best?

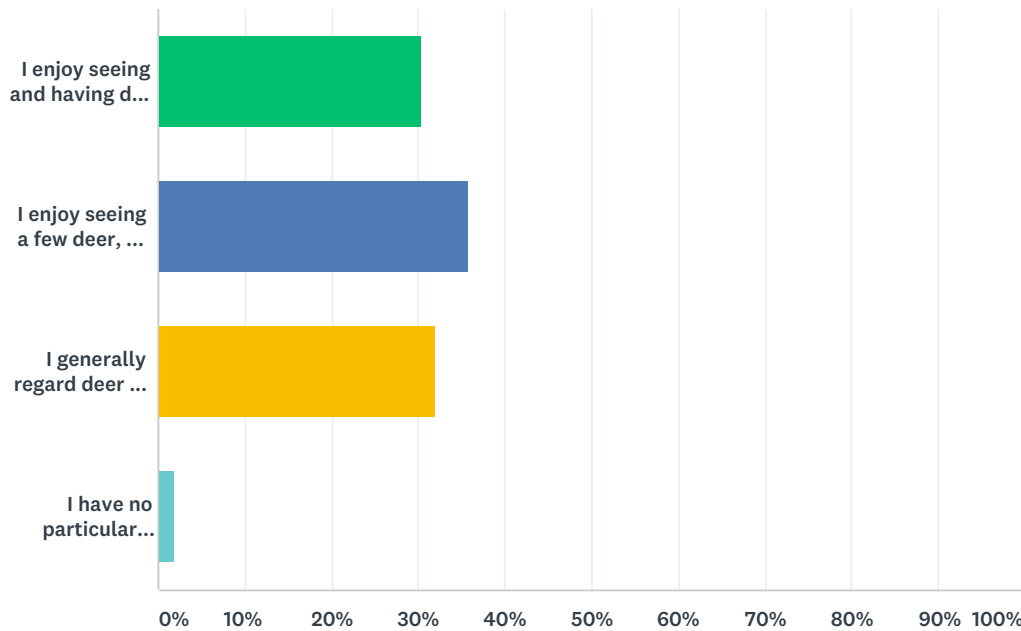

## Q2 Generally, which of the following best describes your feelings about deer in the City of East Lansing?

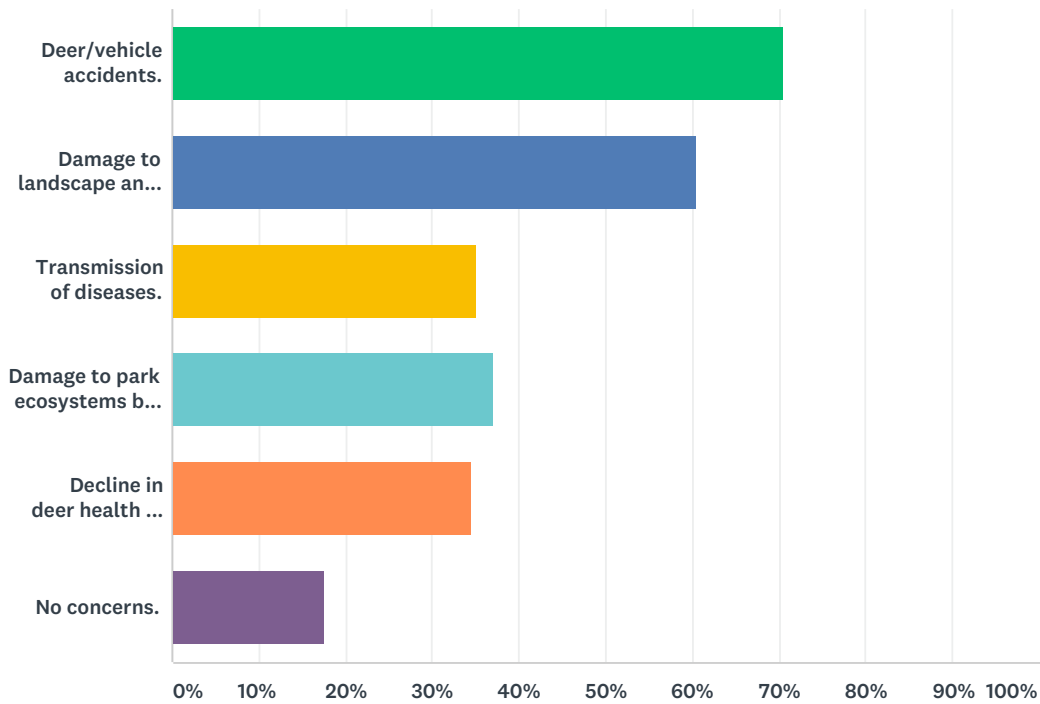

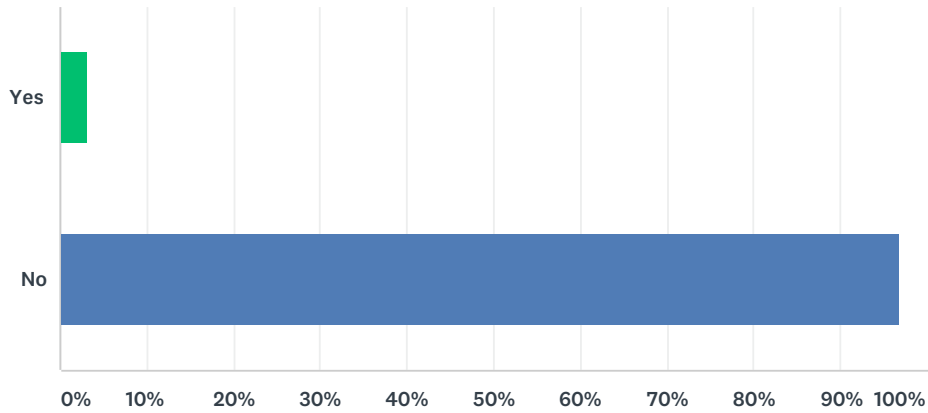

## Q4 Have you been involved in a car/deer accident in the City of East Lansing?

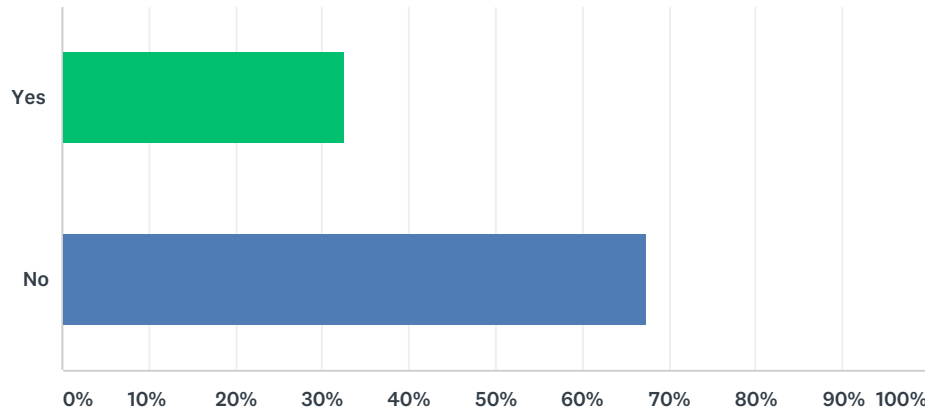

### Q5 Have you been involved in a car/deer accident outside the City of East Lansing?

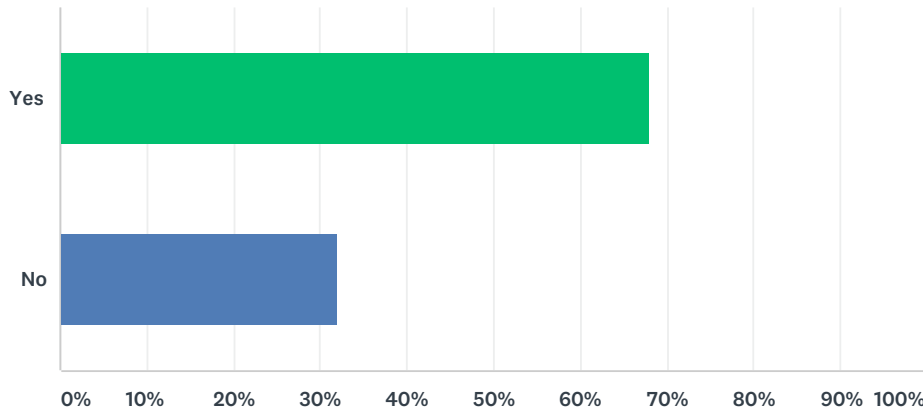

### Q6 Have your garden plants or landscape been damaged by deer?

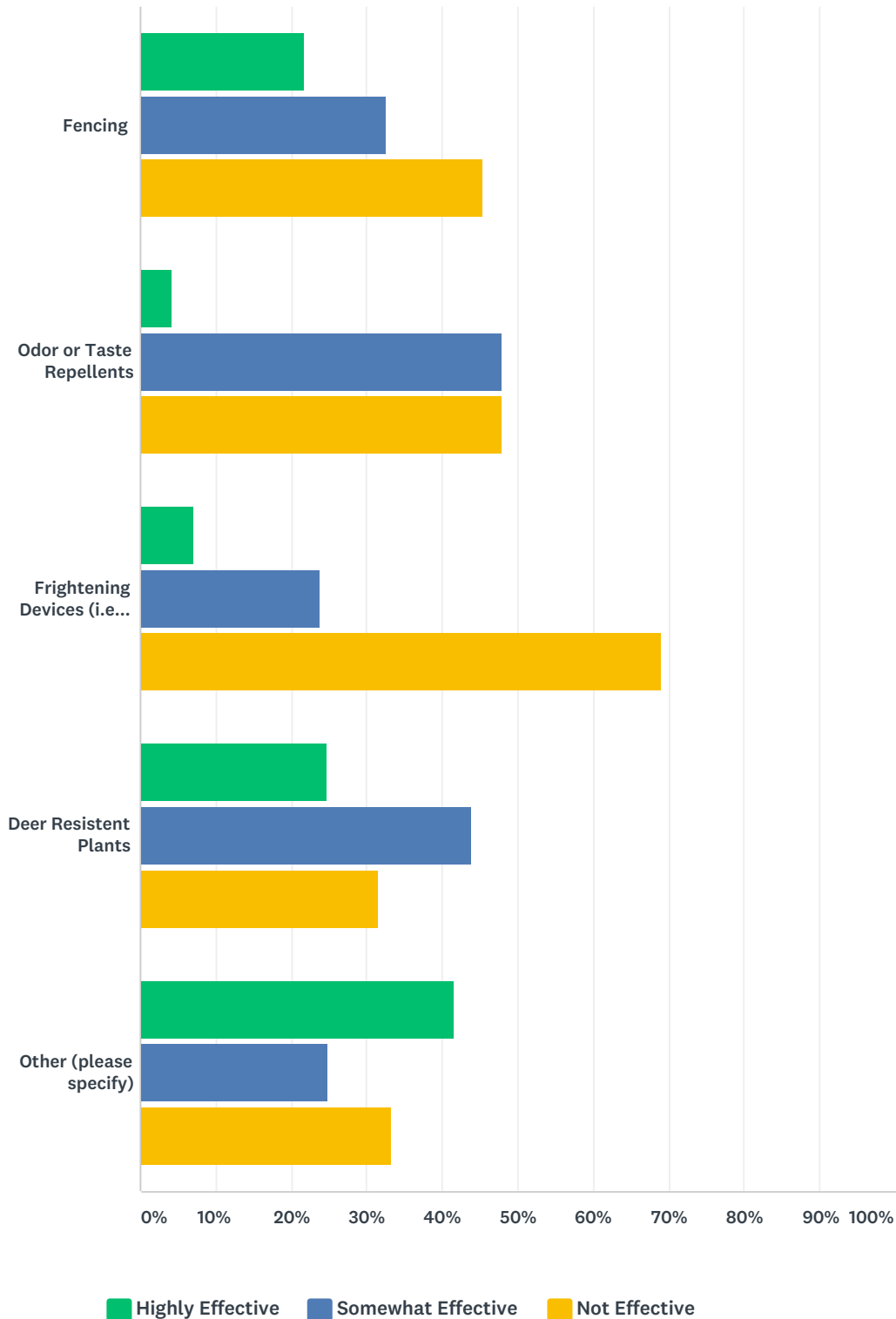

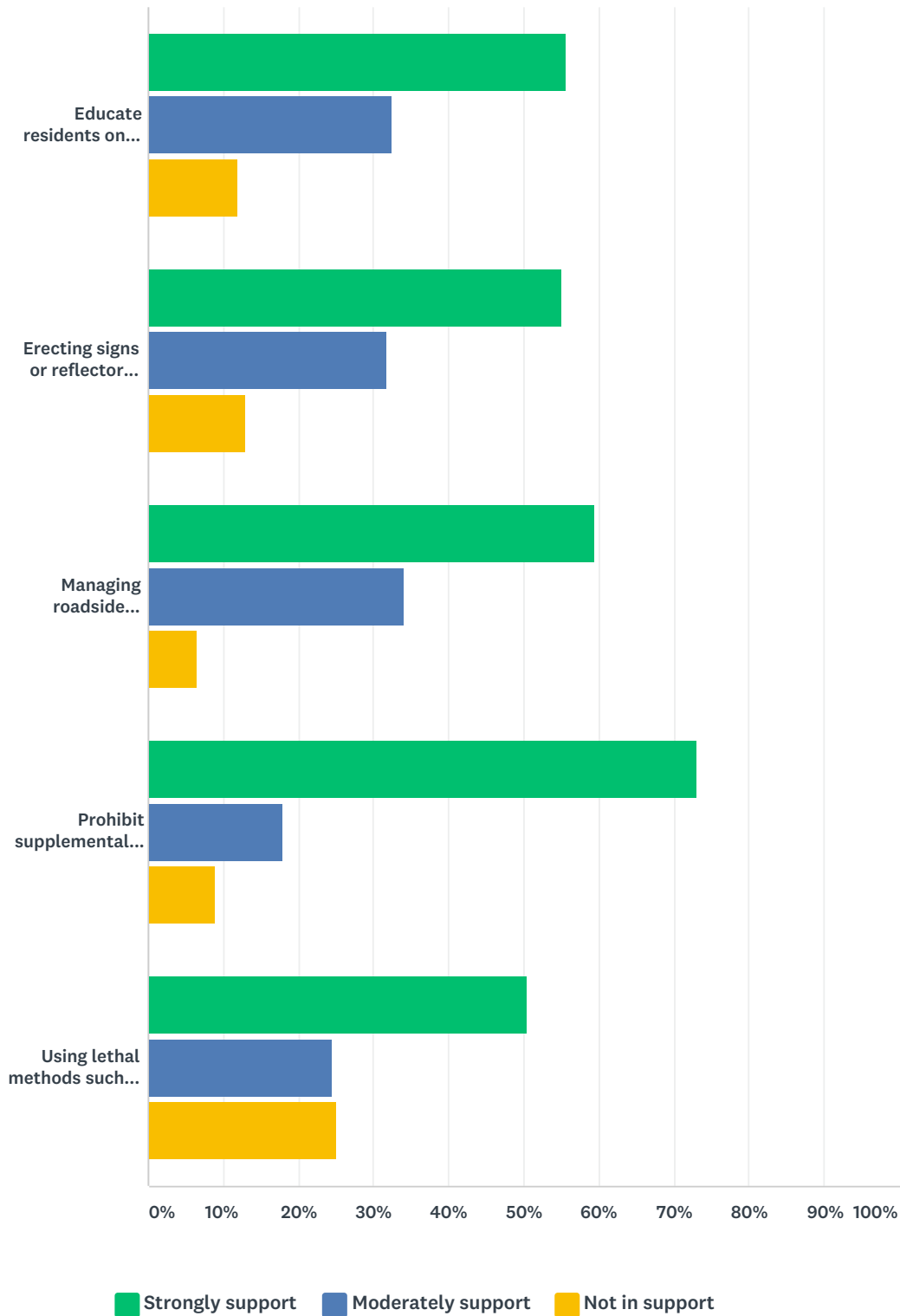

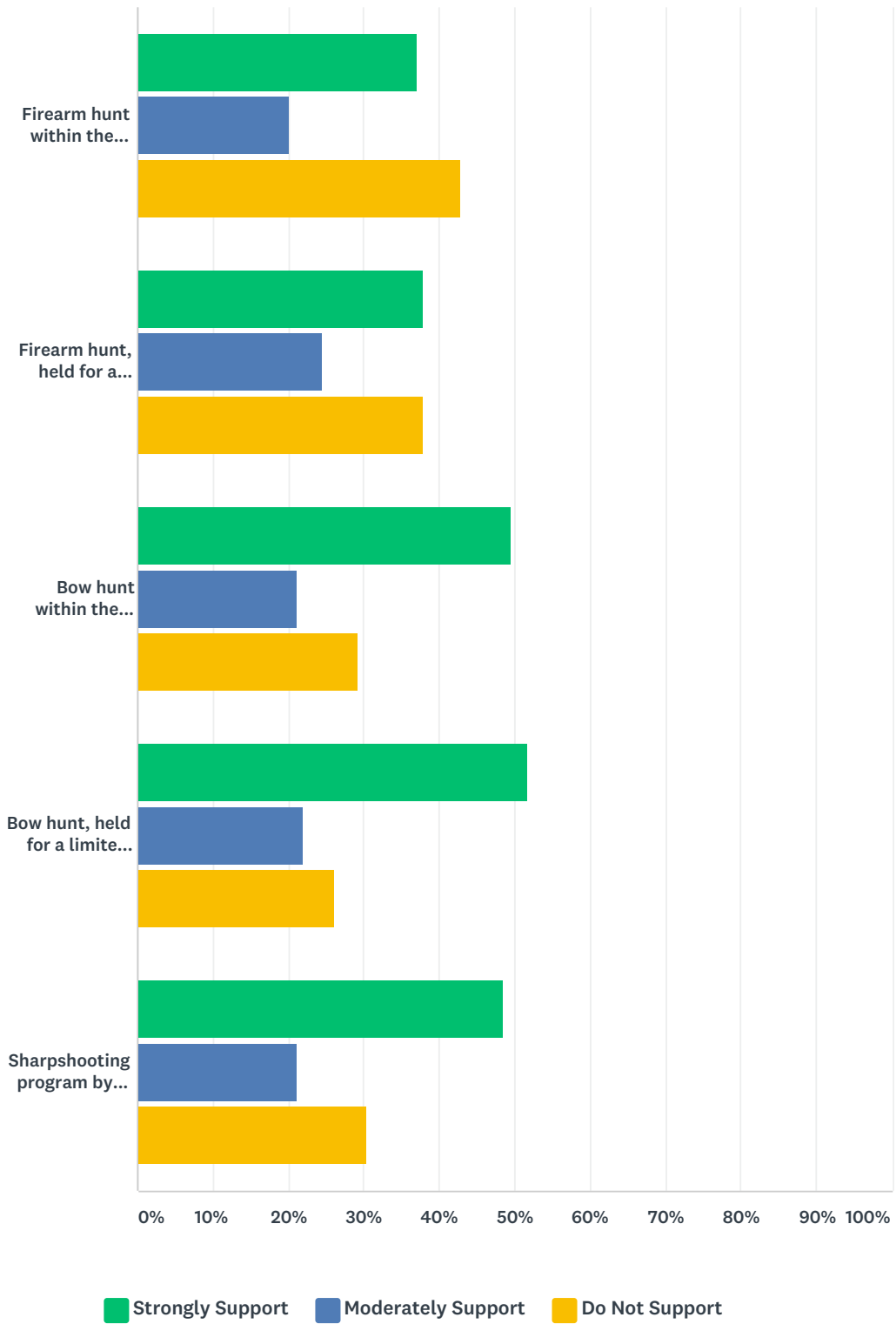

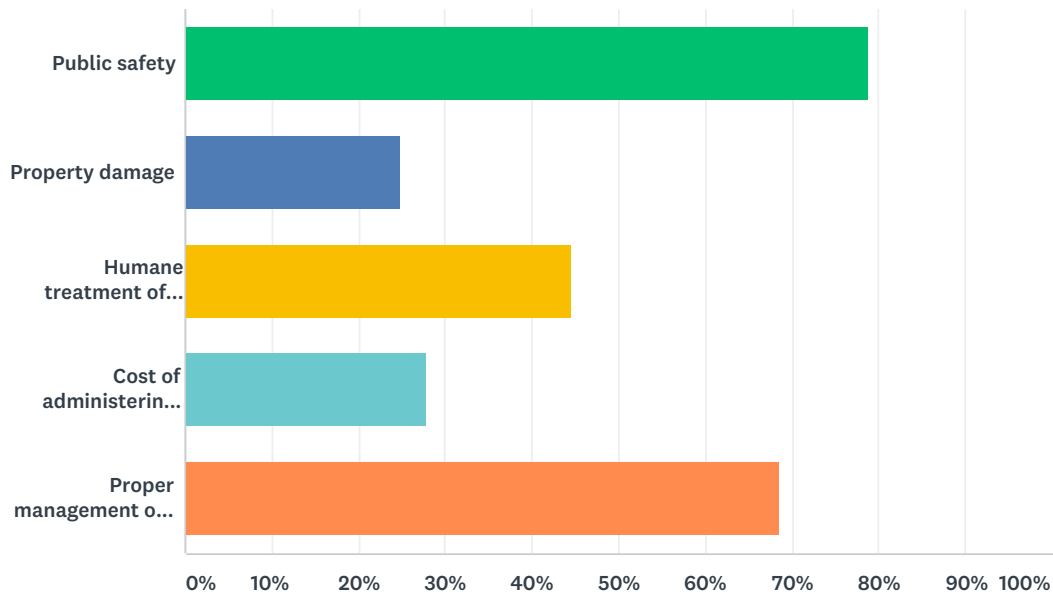

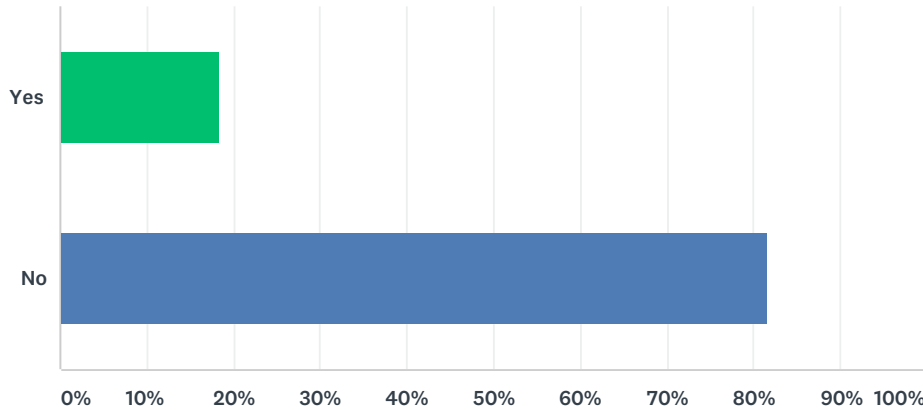

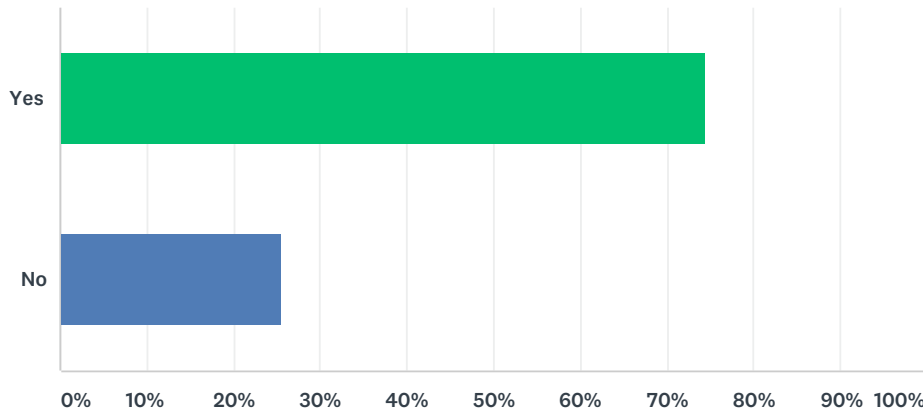

### Q13 Are you aware that Meridian Township recently adopted a deer management plan which allows for managed hunting on Township property and land preserves?

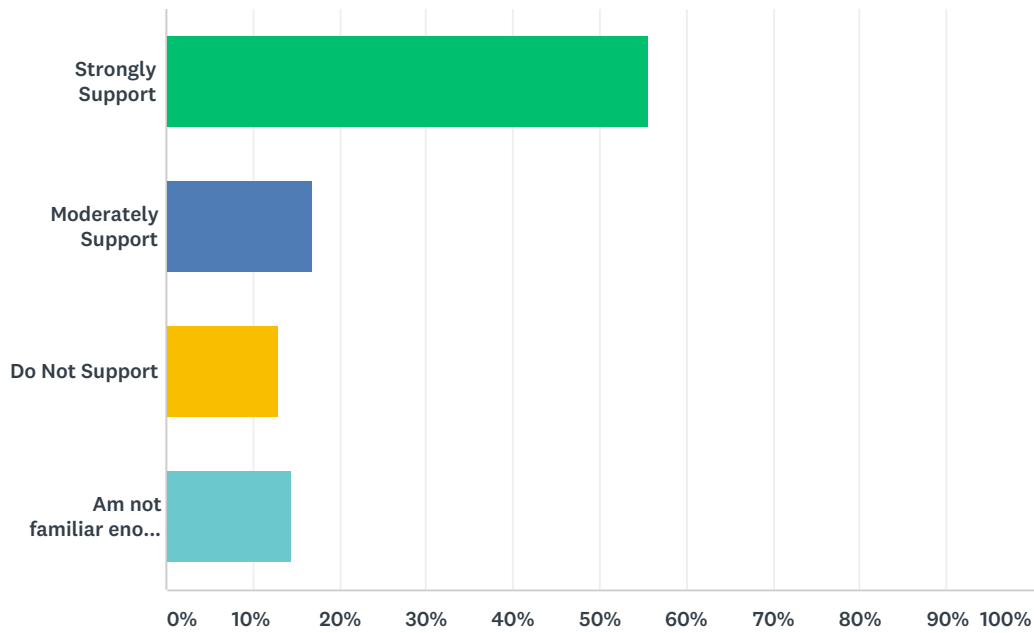
