## INFORMATION

The purpose of each AECT summer camp is to put together a small performance for the last day of camp. During the week (or weeks) of camp, the participants will determine how they want to tell their story; this may involve using an existing script, or writing a new one of their own. Each performance will feature simplistic props, sets, and costumes that are needed to tell the story effectively. The performance will be held on the final day of camp at 11 am, and is free for parents and families to attend.

Unless listed as a musical, the addition of music in any camp is not guaranteed and is up to the discretion of the Camp Leader. Musical camps feature at least one song.
