

**CITY OF EAST LANSING  
POLICY RESOLUTION 2018-8**

**A RESOLUTION TO ALLOW FOR QUARTERLY PAYMENTS  
FOR CERTAIN BUSINESS LICENSES**

**Adopted July 17, 2018**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council for the City of East Lansing establishes restaurant and entertainment business license fees pursuant to its annual budget resolution; and

**WHEREAS**, restaurant business license fees can exceed \$2,000.00 annually for single business license and entertainment business licenses combined with restaurant business licenses to operate from a single location within the City, can exceed \$3,500.00 for combined license fees; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council deems it appropriate to allow for quarterly payments for license fees that exceed \$2,000.00 for any single restaurant business license at a specific location within the City and \$3,500.00 for combined restaurant and entertainment license fees from a single location within the City because said payments can greatly improve a restaurant business licensee's cash flow issues which are peculiar to restaurants within the City and have only a nominal effect on the City budget;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the City Council of the City of East Lansing hereby sets forth the following as a policy regarding the payment of restaurant and entertainment business license fees:

(A) For any single restaurant business license fee that exceeds \$2,000.00 annually, the license fee may be paid in equal quarterly payments without said fee being considered delinquent. One fourth of said payment shall be due on the originally established due date and then one fourth of said payment shall be due every three months thereafter.

(B) For restaurant and entertainment combined business license fees that exceed \$3,500.00 for any single licensee at a single business location within the City, the combined license fees may be paid in equal quarterly payments without any of said license fees being considered delinquent. One fourth of the total license fee shall be due and payable on the originally established due date and then one fourth of said payment shall be due every three months thereafter.




