A RESOLUTION CONCURRING WITH AND CONSENTING TO THE MAYOR'S AUGUST 11, 2020 ORDER ESTABLISHING RULES FOR THE DDA DISTRICT

WHEREAS, the City of East Lansing adopted Ordinance #1488 which authorizes the Mayor to declare or proclaim a City State of Emergency and subsequently promulgate orders rules and regulations in order to protect life and property or to bring the emergency situation under control; and

WHEREAS, in response to the Coronavirus, the Mayor has properly proclaimed and declared a City State of Emergency; and

WHEREAS, in an effort to protect life and bring the emergency under control the Mayor has promulgated rules and regulations requiring persons to wear masks covering their nose and mouth in the DDA District; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Section 10-34e of the Code as well as the order itself, the order ends 7 days after it was issued unless it is consented to by the City Council, in which case the order extends to September 30, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the City Council, concurs with and consents to the terms of the order;

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of East Lansing hereby concurs with and consents to the terms of the order dated August 11, 2020 requiring face masks to be worn in the DDA and extending the order to September 30, 2020 as stated therein.
